




Before and after



Open original picture in Ps after first cropping in Lr




1. Right click on Layer and select 'Duplicate layer'





> Click OK

2. Goto >Filter>Blur>Motion Blur



Play with angle and distance, but recommended is to have 90 degrees for vertical blur! > Click OK

3. Add a mask by clicking left at where the red arrow points



> Press B for Brush and select black color.
Start brushing what you want to be untouched.




Final reveal




4. If you want more stretch? >Select crop tool - Press C




> Click OK

5. >Merge all visible layers by pressing Ctrl+Alt+Shift+E




6. > Select Mark tool - press 'm' and select the part that you want to extend



7. > Select the Transform tool by pressing Ctrl+T and start to drag up but hold shift

> De-select Ctrl+D
